

BREAKDOWN OF THE ISSUES

Federal/State Marriage Amend-

ment: Amendment to the Federal or Iowa Constitution clearly defining marriage as a union between one man and one woman.

School Choice Initiatives:

Such as tuition tax credits.

Retention of Iowa's Right to Work

Law: Current law guarantees that each individual worker can freely choose for themselves whether or not to join or financially support a labor union.

Limit Spending to 99% of

Anticipated Revenue: Amend Iowa's Constitution to limit total state spending to no more than 99% of anticipated state revenue.
